"I Know It's In Here Somewhere": Using Student Interviews to Improve the Search Experience

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Introduction and Purpose

- Evaluate how students are finding electronic resources
- Evaluate usability of the library's website as it pertains to electronic resource access
- Develop and implement a strategy for providing access to electronic resources



ECU Institutional Review Board (IRB)

- Required for human research
- Each member of the research team required to complete training

Sample introduction paragraph for Exempt survey research:

You are being invited to participate in a research study titled "Improving Access to Electronic Library Resources" being conducted by librarians at East Carolina University in Academic Library Services. The interview will take approximately 10 minutes to complete. It is hoped that this information will assist us to better understand how library users find and access electronic library resources. Your responses will be kept confidential, and no data will be released or used with your identification attached. Your participation in the research is voluntary. You may choose not to answer any or all questions, and you may stop at any time. There is no penalty for not taking part in this research study. Methodology

Set up in lobby with two laptops

- Students greeted by ALS student library employee
- Conducted 60 interviews asking three questions about e-resource access
- Noted student's class rank and any details of search process



Interview questions

Assignment A

- Watch the video **A Slave Of Love**. It's available streaming from the library.
- Read the book *Essays of Travel* by Robert Louis Stevenson. It's available as an e-book from the library.
- Write a research paper on sleep deprivation in students. You must cite 3 journal articles.




Student status (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, grad)


No significant difference between classes

Percentage of Questions Answered Successfully






Success rate high on all questions



- One of the ebooks was not in the portal (5)
- Incorrect tool used (2)
- Typo in search (1)
- Could not recognize ebook in results list (1)





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Success (52)

Question 3: Journal articles

Successful (52)

- One Search (41)
- Databases (6)
- Google Scholar (5)

Unsuccessful (8)

- Incorrect tool used (6)
- Searched wrong thing (1)
- Couldn't determine which database to use (1)



Observations

- "I know it's in here somewhere"
- Students repeatedly executing the same search in the same place even though no results were being returned
- Some students turned to databases that they were familiar with or search strategies they were trained to use in their disciplines
- Search skills did not appear to be influenced by class. Some freshmen were skilled at searching while some seniors were not
- Many students scrolled up and down the homepage before executing a search
- Students often expressed feeling like they were failing. We had to remind them that we were testing our website.



Conclusions

Key observations:

- Although One Search was the 1st or 2nd choice for most students, they did have difficulty identifying the best place to start.
- Many students made one or more incorrect choices before they chose the right place to search.
- The library catalog was rarely used.

As a result we need to:


- Fine-tune search interfaces










Recommendation to DAB

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
