



In many community college libraries, libraries host their website on their own using LibGuides, a product from Springshare.




The Problem

Outdated Site




Learn from others


Getting inspiration is always a great place to start in the design process. Since we already knew we wanted to change the site, we started thinking about basic design choices many libraries use.


Wireframing & Mockups


After collecting information on how other libraries are making their websites, and thinking about what we already wanted, we needed to create a wireframe and mockup for approval.



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New ILS and OPAC

While also designing a new library website, we were also launching a new ILS and OPAC through Evergreen in partnership with MOBIUS.

We wanted the design to blend and match, and this is what the end mockup looked like.



Coding

LibGuides vs. LibGuides CMS

Springshare provides two levels of LibGuides: LibGuides and LibGuides CMS. CMS provides more advanced customization and services for an additional fee. Springshare's products are currently migrating from Bootstrap 3 to Bootstrap 5, which is a CSS framework for mobile-first development.

Front-End Development

In order to customize LibGuides to be how you really want it, you need to have front-end development knowledge. The most common languages to know for this is HTML, CSS, and JavaScript. It's also good to know some frameworks, like Bootstrap and Angular.

Responsive Sites

It's important to also make sure your website formats correctly on any type of device. This is called responsive development. If you know the majority of your clientele uses their phones, you can use a mobile-first design model.




LibGuides customization

You must have an Admin level account to do site-wide customization to your site.

You can make a LibGuide your library homepage; it doesn't have to be the default.

You do site-wide customization in Admin -Look & Feel. You can either type all of your code in the box or insert a CSS file below that. It is better practice to insert a CSS file.

You can also input customizations and code to your headers and footers, such as making a navigation bar.



Idea: Project Outcome

It was at this point that we felt we needed more input from students who would be using the library website.

The library already did surveys from Project Outcome at the end of each session, so we took already existing survey answers and new survey answers to steer into the new direction of how to make the website.






Project Outcome

Project Outcome is a FREE online toolkit designed to help libraries understand and share the impact of essential library programs and services by providing simple surveys and an easy-to-use process for measuring and analyzing outcomes.

Project Outcome provides libraries with FREE access to quick and simple patron surveys, an easy-to-use survey management tool to collect their outcomes, custom reports and interactive data dashboards for analyzing the data, and various resources to help move libraries from implementing surveys to taking action using the results.



Lenoir Community College - Leigh & John McNairy Library staff distributed surveys to program participants to collect data and insights about how their research services and programs support user needs. Lenoir Community College - Leigh & John McNairy Library surveyed patrons using the Project Outcome Research Survey, which measures the impact of services designed to improve research skills and help researchers succeed. A total of 20 survey responses were collected.

Results

A total of 20 survey responses were collected. Of the patrons surveyed, the following percentages either agreed or strongly agreed that they benefited from the program or service:



100% learned something new to help with their research




